All students from Reception to Year 7 are required to wear the school uniform, including black shoes, daily.

We believe that wearing the uniform promotes a sense of belonging and school pride. It also enables the identification of students who are not part of our school and also reduces peer pressure.

The school uniform shop is open on Monday's at 8:30 a.m. for the purchase of uniform items.

All students are required to wear a school approved sun safe hat daily.

Jewellery items such as large earrings, piercings, large necklaces and chains can be an Occupational Health and Safety risk. In order for students to actively participate in all curriculum areas, we ask that students do not wear these items to school.
